

Consignment Terms

- 1. Up to ten individual items of New York State postal history or closely related ephemera may be consigned to this auction. Individual items may be grouped into a lot, but the space allowed for its description and image will remain consistent with the space allowed to other lots.
- 2. I am *not* a postal history expert so **please provide relevant information you believe necessary to properly describe the consigned lots.** As necessary I will edit this information for brevity and make any changes that are necessary for clarity. **Use the reverse, or a separate sheet if necessary.**
- 3. **State a Minimum Bid for each lot.** Consignors should assign a Minimum Bid to each lot of *at least* \$1. Consignors should remember that their Minimum Bid constitutes the price at which the lot will be awarded in the event it draws only one Bid. Otherwise, lots will be awarded at one increment over the underbid.
- 4. All unsold lots will be returned at the conclusion of the auction at Consignor's expense.
 Unsold lots will be packaged and shipped in the same manner as received from Consignor.
 Shipping costs not covered by auction proceeds due to Consignor will be separately invoiced.
