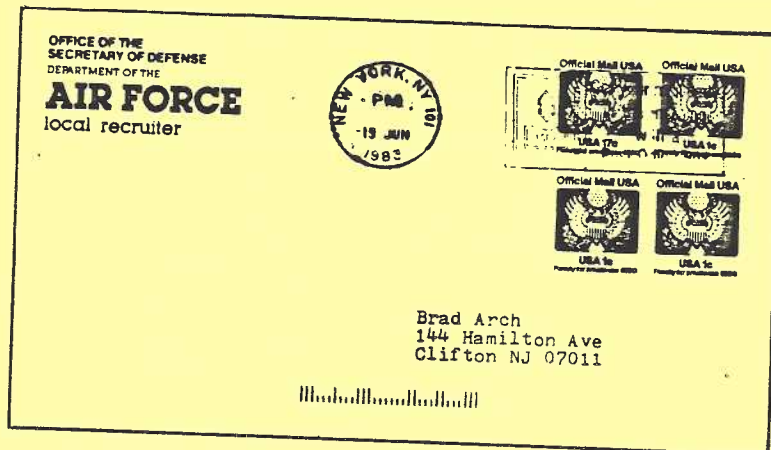

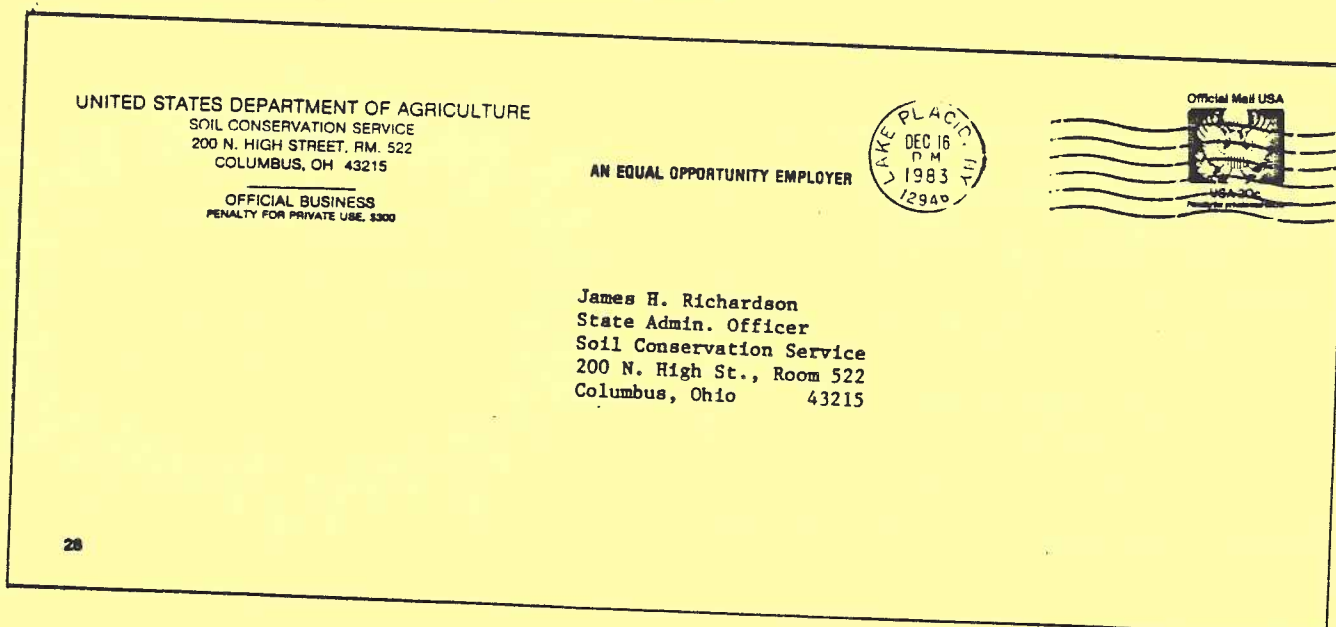
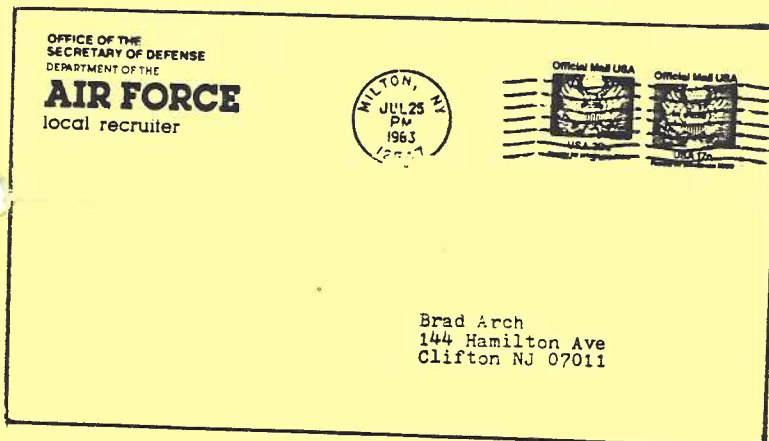


1983 OFFICIALS - The First Year

Issued in January 1983 for effective use on February 1st, the Test Period use being limited to the Soil Conservation Service of the Department of Agriculture, and the Recruiting Service of the Air Force.

Commercial external use is extremely scarce, with internal inter-office use only slightly more readily available, due to many individual offices policy of not allowing the discarded envelopes to reach the commercial or philatelic market.

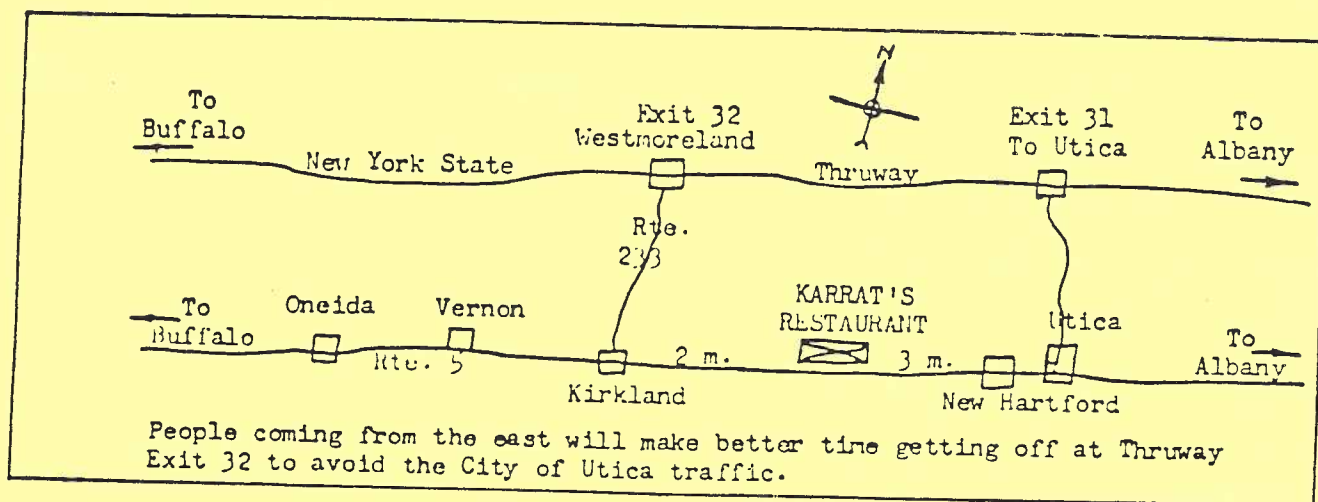
ESPHS members and guests are all welcome to attend the semi-annual meeting.



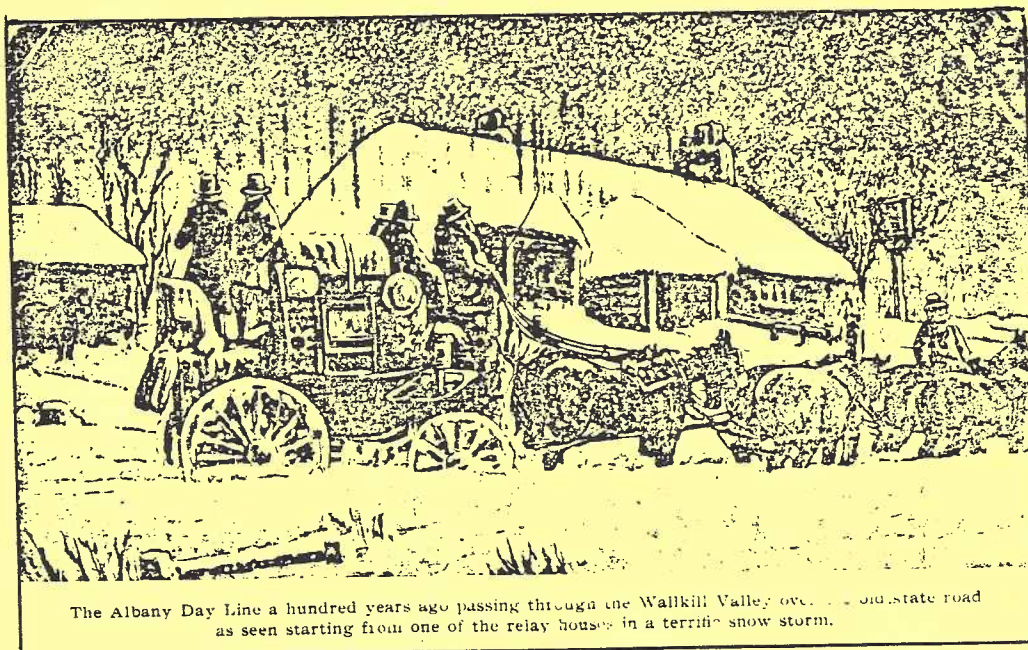
SHOW TIME

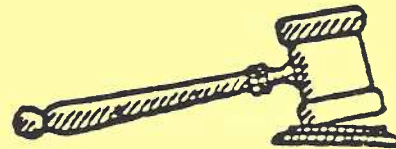
