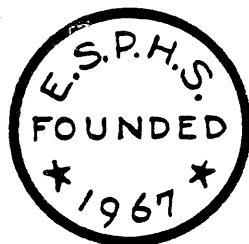

Congratulations to our winners!

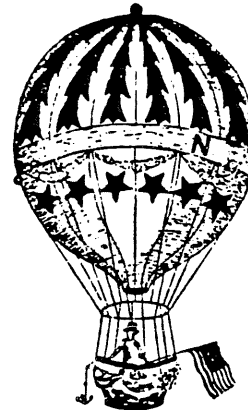
