

TYPE 27 - Negative star with solid circle in center in a solid circle


TYPE 28 - Fancy outline of a six sided star in a solid circle.

TYPE 30 - Like type 2 but negative circle in center of star


TYPE 31 - Like type 5 but with negative circle in center of star






The "Bulletin" is always in need of good articles. Take a little time out to put your favorite story on paper. Share your collection with others.



NOTICE REGARDING NOMINATIONS
