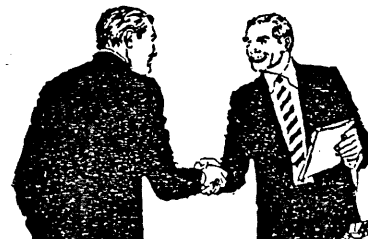

Meet The Members



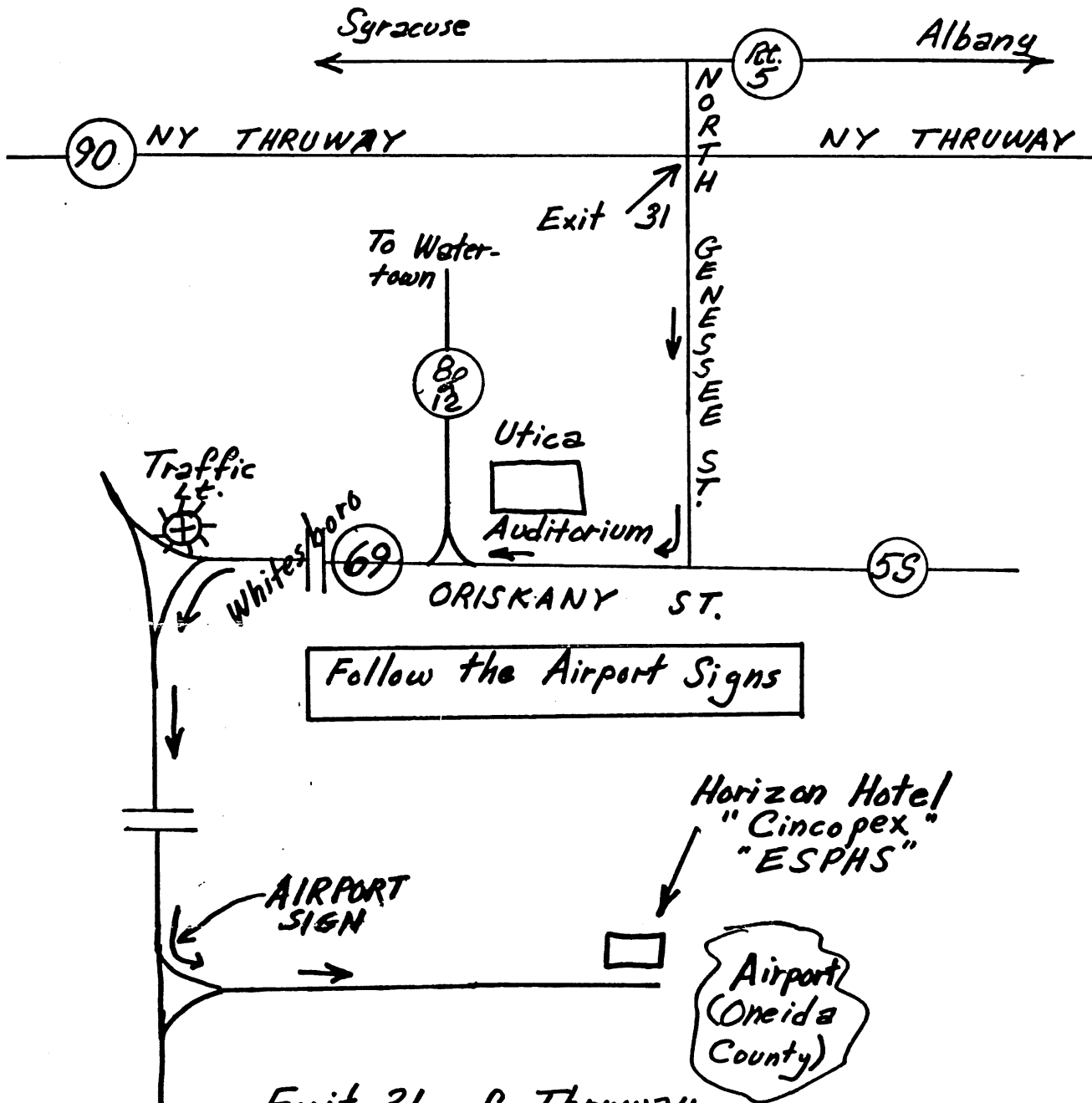
Louis Thornton Call, Jr.

Our new president was born in 1928 in Camden, New Jersey. His parents moved around a lot and he went to schools in Ilion, NY; Albany, NY, including Albany Academy and Milne High School; and Burlington, Vt High School where he graduated in 1946.

Lou served with the US Army from 1947 to 1949 with the Adjutant General, mostly filing papers. A year and a half of this time was spent in Japan. After service Lou went to Canterbury College in Dansville, Ind, where he took English and Secondary School Education. He graduated with a BS in Education from the University of Vermont in 1951. After school Lou drove busses for Vermont Transit, Greyhound and others.

In 1954 he was teaching High School Social Studies in Haddonfield, New Jersey. From Glasboro State College Lou got a masters degree in reading. This was followed by jobs in the Branchburg and North Plainfield, New Jersey Schools. During this period Lou worked part time nights and week ends at Applebaums in Philadelphia.

In 1967 Lou married Nancy Sanders, a high school teacher at North Plainfield. They have a daughter, Paulette. Lou's doctorate was earned in reading at the University of Georgia in 1974.

Lou took a position with Russell Sage College in 1974, and then in 1981 with the Herkimer County Community College where he was Professor of Humanities until he retired on December 31, 1992.

One of Lou's hobbies is reading, collecting and trying to write children's literature. He recently donated his collection of children's literature to the Herkimer college. But stamps have been the main thing all this time. His mother started him off when he was eight years old and he has never stopped. One of his interests is Japan, obviously from the time he spent there in the Army days. He claims his interest in the Mexican Overprint States is because they were cheap. In addition to postal stationery, railroad markings have held high interest for Lou.

Lou is a life member of the Mexico Elmhurst Int Soc, Mobil Post Office Society, the Japan Society, and the Postal Stationery Society. Besides being a member of the Albany Fort Orange Stamp Club, the Empire State Postal History Society, and Secretary of the Hellenic Philatelic Society he found time to be a president of the Winter Haven, Florida Stamp Club!

Lou writes for the RR Society and PS among others and is a active exhibitor of many types of collections. He also is a part time stamp dealer.

Lou certainly brings a wide philatelic background to his presidency of the ESPHS and he is looking forward to getting into philatelic things in a big way now that he has retired.

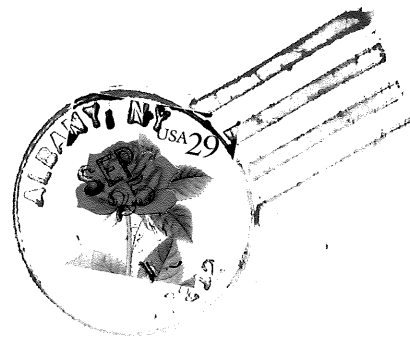
