Semi-Annual Meeting Oneonta Holiday Inn Sunday, Sept. 22, 1996

The meeting was held at the site of "Cincopex 96", a philatelic exhibition sponsored by five regional stamp clubs. It is an annual event and rotates among the five Cincopex clubs in the central NY area. A buffet breakfast was served in the morning for the earlier attendees with lunch later.

The meeting ws called to order by President Call at approximately 1:30 pm. Twelve members were able to attend. The Secretary was asked to summarize results of the Executive Board meeting held the previous week with further input from the membership welcomed.

- 1. The application for membership for Neil Hawk was rejected by the Board because: (a) an objection from a member re failure to pay for covers purchased, (b) expulsion in 1987 from the APS for failure to pay for books at auction, (c) expulsion in 1995 from the PMCC for failure to return a borrowed microfilm and (d) failure to reply to official correspondence from the ESPHS Sec.
- 2. Possibility of life membership made available for X dollars. After discussion, no motion was made and the subject was dropped.
- 3. Ken de Lisle announced that the ESPHS has been informed of a bequest of \$2000 from the estate of member John Whittlesey to be used at the Society's discretion. Ken was appointed by President Call to form a committee to draft a proposal to the Executive Board as how to use the bequest when received. Ken solicits suggestions (in writing, please)

- 5. Status of Doane Cancel book. Maris Tirums is the editor and is aiming for publication in May, 1997. Maris is fairly well along, but still solicits input on types and observed date(s) of usage. Comments on scarcity will also be welcomed; however, the decision on whether to use "scarcity factors" is fluid and may or may not be implemented. Maris wil prepare a page for the Nov. 96 *Stamp Insider* to be received not later than Oct. 15.
- 6. Bulletin/Journal mailings: Steve Matte has volunteered to take over the copy/mailing function of the Bulletin/Journal combined mailings, which is a big aid.
- 7. Drew Nicholson asked if a bibiliogrpahy of NYS Postal History articles exists, particularily including our own Bulletin/Journal. The short answer is no, although Bill Bauer said he has a box of material received from Bill Hart and the American Philatelic Research Library is a possible source. Drew is willing to work on this and was encouraged to do so.
- 8. There was a lengthy discussion on how to get more recognition of our society. It would be helpful to have more volunteers to sit behind the ESPHS table at ROPEX; Dick Lohrman mentioned that the PA PH Society meets monthly, is active, and that material at the meetings is eagerly bought and sold


